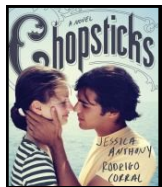

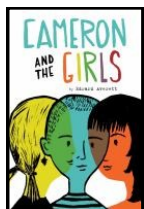

#### **Anthem for Jackson Dawes**

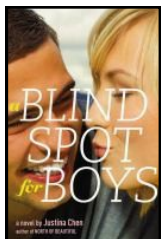

**A Time For Dancing**



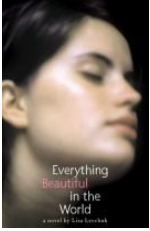

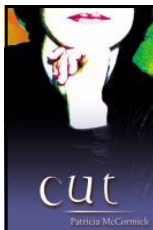
**Second Chance Summer**
