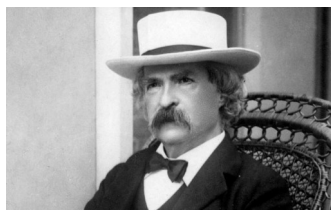

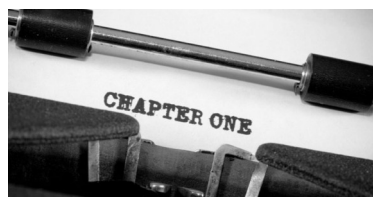


Cluttered Lives: Hoarding

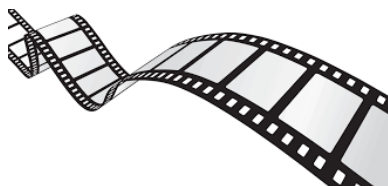
Winter Nesters for Seniors

Washtenaw Reads Authors

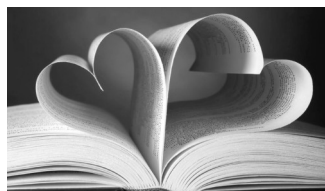
