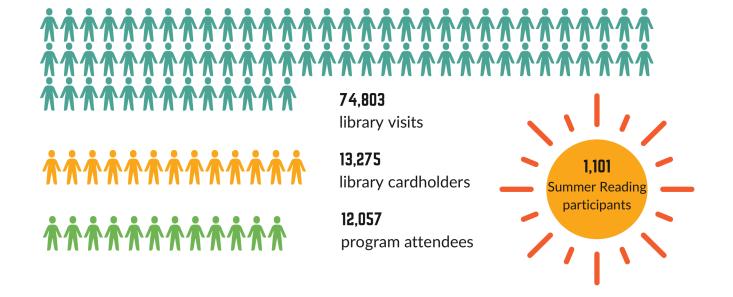
2020-2021 ANNUAL REPORT

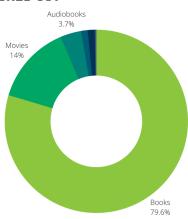

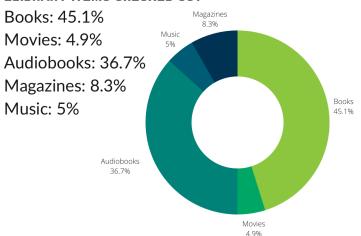
